

FEDERAL BUDGET 2024-25: WHAT IT MEANS FOR CARERS

Who are Australia's carers?

Over 2.65 million Australians provide unpaid care and support to family members and friends who have a disability, mental illness, chronic condition, terminal illness, an alcohol or other drug issue or who are frail aged.

According to our 2023 **Carer Wellbeing Survey:**

47%

of carers in paid work reported they were doing less paid work than they want to.

68%

of carers reported low satisfaction with their ability to do further education or training.

Budget wins for carers:



\$18.6 million to support Carer Payment recipients through increased flexibility to undertake work, study and volunteering activities.



\$318 million for a one-year freeze on the maximum cost of a Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (PBS) prescription.



\$531.4 million for an extra 24,100 aged care Home Care Packages.



\$3.5 billion cost-ofliving package including a \$300 discount on energy bills for every household.
